### Wilmington VA Schedules Town Hall Meeting

The Wilmington VAMC will continue a series of Veterans Town Hall Meetings this November. The next meeting for Veterans in lower Delaware is Nov. 20, 12 p.m. - 1 p.m., at the Levy Court Building, 555 Bay Rd., Dover, DE.
