ORDINANCE No. 09-01 EMERGENCY OPERATION PLAN (EOP)

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, TOWN OF TOWNSEND, DELAWARE RELATING TO THE ADOPTION OF AN EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TOWNSEND (a majority of the members elected thereto concurring therein):

Section 1. That the Code of Ordinances, Town of Townsend, Delaware is hereby amended by adding a new article and section to appear in Chapter 2 thereof to be numbered 2-100, which said section shall read as follows:

ARTICLE VI. EMERGENCY OPERATIONS

Sec. 2-100. Emergency Operations Plan.

That a certain document, three copies of which are on file on the office of the town clerk of the town, being marked and designated as the Emergency Operations Plan of 2009 be and is hereby adopted into law to prepare for, respond to and recover from domestic incidents, regardless of cause, size, or complexity and to do so with an approach that is consistent with other state local and Federal agencies.

SYNOPSIS

This Act adopts the Emergency Operations Plan of 2009 consistent with the National Incident Management System (NIMS) developed and administered by the Department of Homeland Security to enhance preparedness and implement uniform procedures for responding to disasters and domestic incidents.
