I. Call to Order: 6 pm.

II. Opening Ceremonies

A. Roll Call: Mayor S. Lobdell, Councilwoman S. Rojas, Councilman J. Mertz, Councilman E. Dugan, Councilwoman E. Clarke, Town Meetings will return to both an in person and a virtual format.

- B. Pledge of Allegiance: All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.
- C. Recognition of Visitors: Steve Seidman via zoom and Dwain Haines.
- D. Announcements:
 - 1. Mayor announced he spoke at the Chamber of Commerce event that occurred last week and advised the Town received recognition for the Back-to-School Event.
- III. Citizens Comments & Participation
 - A. None.
- IV. Adoption of Agenda.
 - A. CM Mertz made a motion to adopt the agenda. CW Rojas seconded the motion. Voice vote of Council: all yea's.
 - 1. Council adopted agenda.
- V. Reports:
 - A. Town Manager Antonina Tantillo
 - 1. **ACTION ITEM:** Discussion and possible vote to authorize the work to the Town Park gazebo façade.
 - a. TM Tantillo explained the stonework on the Gazebo has deteriorated requiring repair. TM Tantillo advised per inspections from Town Staff and the Town's Insurance Assessor, damage is not a result of vandalism. TM Tantillo is awaiting the final report from the Insurance Assessor to determine if or how much coverage they will provide.
 - b. Council discussed the following quotes as presented by TM Tantillo:
 - i. Roger Rullo:
 - a) The price range for replacement cost is \$17,800.00 to \$19,000.00.
 - ii. Gary Rullo:

- a) The replacement cost is \$24,900.00.
- b) The repair cost is \$14,500.00.

iii. EDIS:

- a) The cost to repair two sections is \$18,126.00
- b) The cost to replace all the stone is \$35,886.00
- c) The cost to replace all the stone with stucco is \$24,126.00.
- d) TM Tantillo noted the Town has used this company for chimney repairs at Town Hall.
- c. CM Mertz made a motion to table the possible vote to authorize the work to the Town Park gazebo façade until final results are received by the Town's insurance company. CW Clarke seconded the motion. Voice vote of Council: all yea's.
 - i. Council voted to table possible vote to authorize the work to the Town Park gazebo façade.

 - ACTION ITEM: Discussion and possible vote regarding Resolution 2023-006 A

 - Mayor Lobdell introduced the discussion and possible vote regarding Resolution 2023-006 A Resolution to Affirm the Adoption of the FY 24 Municipal Budget.
 - b. FO Helms provided an overview of the FY 24 Budget Presentation prepared.
 - c. TM Tantillo advised Town Council they may further discuss the budget in executive session.
 - d. Town Council discussed each line item of the FY 24 Budget and options for how the Town may proceed with hiring additional police officer(s).
 - e. Town Council compared the approved FY 23 Budget and the proposed FY 24 Budget.
 - f. Mayor Lobdell noted for the record that the police department building addition was removed and explained that at the Finance Committee meeting Chief Longo confirmed an additional police officer was more important over expansion of the Police Department Building.
 - g. Chief Longo noted for the record if a layoff were needed due to budgeting, he would opt for the layoff. Chief Longo explained he wants to ensure the Town is protected.
 - h. Town Council agreed to vote after executive session, noting further discussion is needed regarding the FY 24 Budget.
