Overview:

At the request of the Townsend Police Department, Advantech completed a site assessment of the Townsend Municipal Park and surrounding area. The focus of this assessment was providing a video surveillance system.

As a result of these assessments, it is Advantech's recommendation to install a new cloud video surveillance system with bullet, 360, and multi-sensor cameras which shall increase situational awareness.

Video Surveillance – Scope of Work:

Video Surveillance programming can be complicated and time consuming to learn. The reason is that there are numerous options for recording speed, motion detection, and alerts. In addition, traditional video system architecture requires a database server or appliance on site and the associated IT infra-structure to support it. Without individuals who have the expertise, training and availability; managing this tool can become time consuming and frustrating. Also, eliminating the need for a video server/appliance on site eliminates the need to maintain video storage.

Hosted Video – Advantech shall host the video system on a cloud server. The client can access the video at any time via web browser and download/save video clips to it's local computers.








Gazebo 4 Sensor: Imager 3




Gazebo 4 Sensor: Imager 4








Pavilion 4 Sensor: Imager 3




Pavilion 4 Sensor: Imager 4
