- IV. **Minutes from February 9<sup>th</sup> Planning Commission meetings to review and approve.** James moved to accept the minutes; Lisa seconded. Everyone voted to approve.
- V. Review of finalized recommendations for Future Land Use Type of parcels and map proposed to be added to the Future Land Use & Growth & Annexation Areas map. The planning commission reviewed the blank parcels. The planning commission will use the NCC Designation, except in the case where there is more than one designation. The changes can be reviewed once the properties are annexed into the Town and apply for changes through the Town. The NCC designation "Suburban Reserve" will be designated as Residential. Where Farmland is designated by the Planning Commission, should be changed to "Suburban Reserve". James moved to send the Future Land Use & Growth & Annexation Areas map with changes to PLUS and Lisa seconded. Everyone voted to move forward.
