Long Real Estate Investments LLC seeks variance to allow for a self- storage facility as the parcel is situated in the Town of Townsend Commercial District (C) pursuant to the Town's Official Zoning Map. The Town's Zoning Code (the "Code") does not expressly provide self-storage facilities as permitted uses under a commercial classification. Upon further review, it was discovered that the Code does not permit selfstorage under any of the Town's zoning classifications. Because self-storage is not expressly set forth as a permitted use in Section 24.12.070(B), nor any other sections of the Code, the Town has requested that the Applicant submit this application to the Board of Adjustment.
