- **V.** Approval/ Rejection of minutes:

- VI. Discussion and Review of municipal code for discrepancies and required edits.
 - A. Tm Goodyear states that an edit was made to our code reflecting parking on Main St to all streets must be on the right-hand side. However, the fee schedule does not reflect a fine for this.
 - 1. Chief Longo responded that the DE state code has a fee that is generally charged, it does not have to be reflected in the Town fee schedule.
 - B. CM Chapman reads title 21 that the ticket must be attached to the vehicle it's being given to, not in the mailbox or other area.
 - 1. TM Goodyear clarifies with Chief Longo that this is only additional verbiage being added and that no changes were made.
 - 2. Chief Longo replies yes, it is the State Statute and shares that it is also helpful should the Town hire a Code Enforcement Officer, they would then be allowed to ticket the vehicle as well.
 - C. CM Chapman recommends clarifying with TS Hatfield, who would be legally responsible for citations issued, on behalf of the Town.

- D. CM Chapman reads Delaware title 41-79 stopping, standing, or parking for the right side of Main St.
 - 1. Chief Longo recommends taking out Delaware title 41-79 but keeping stopping, standing, or parking.
 - I. TM Goodyear agreed and added that we should refer to our fee schedule for the fine.
- E. TM Goodyear reads title 16.08.10 on abandoned vehicles.
 - 1. CM Chapman states he does not agree with citing citizens for their own private property.
 - 2. Mayor Lobdell mentions the title 16.08.30 assumption of abandonment which describes how a vehicle could be presumed abandoned.
 - I. TM Goodyear states we could change the location to either a covered structure or the rear of the property to keep the aesthetic.
 - 3. TM Goodyear recommended adding further investigation of ordinance for the next Code Review agenda.
