**RE:** Summary and Recommendation – RFP Responses for Engineering Services and Code Review & Inspection Services

#### Overview

The Town of Townsend issued Requests for Proposals (RFPs) for two service categories:

- 1. Engineering Services
- 2. Code Review & Inspection Services

Six (6) firms submitted proposals:

- Remington & Vernick Engineers (RVE)
- Davis, Bowen & Friedel, Inc. (DBF)
- VanDemark & Lynch, Inc. (V&L)
- First State Inspection Agency (FSIA)
- Verdantas
- Pennoni

Each proposal was reviewed across key criteria including firm background, services offered, team qualifications, relevant municipal experience, fee structure, and unique strengths. A summary comparison table is also included for quick reference.
