- **I.** Call to Order: Approximately 7:03pm.
- **II.** Opening Ceremonies

 - 1. Mayor Lobdell states that Town is waiting on updated reassessments information.

- B. New Castle County Councilman David Carter
 - NCC CM Carter shared he does not have an update on his federal housing funds due to the Gov shut down. He ensures despite the shut down his staff and himself are still working hard to create equal housing opportunities.
- C. Town of Townsend Police Chief's Report
 - CM Wiggins commended Chief Longo on his acquisition of new free items for their new PD build.
 - ACTION ITEM: Discussion and review of updates on hiring new members of Police Force.
 - i. Chief Longo stated there has been no luck on hiring a new member of the Police force. Feedback from those interviewed is that the starting salary is too low.
 - TM Goodyear asks if the PD will be paying to send the recruit to the academy.
 - a. Chief Longo replied yes, there is savings from losing an officer that would go towards sending the recruit to the academy.

- 2. TM Goodyear raises finance concerns about the hiring of an officer whilst sending them to the academy due to the allotted budget.
 - a. Chief Longo disputes that without officer Hart on the payroll, the PD has been saving what would have been his salary to put towards the academy which will not infringe on the allotted budget.
- 3. TM Goodyear asks Council to consider an expectation on payback when there is a new hire to compensate the Town if they do not fulfil duties.

 - Council members all agree that the average speed rate does not call for additional police activity since it was within the speed limit.

 - ii. CM Chapman and CM Wiggins agree with taking the items to atleast committee level. They also recommended Chief create a list of items that he would be looking for and have committee pre-approve the items before bidding on them.
